FROM NICHOLAS

Today, is All Saints Sunday, our patronal festival, when we rejoice in the communion of saints which we profess in the creed – those faithful Christians through the ages who have run the race, kept the faith, and with us, await the crown of glory. A few saints may be formally recognised in the Church's calendar, the vast majority are not. My favourite definition of a 'saint' is a sinner whose life has been redeemed by grace. On this feast day we rejoice in God's immeasurable grace and rejoice in the love and witness of all the saints in whose number we too will one day be counted.

Today, we are also choosing to observe Safeguarding Sunday. You may think it is an odd juxtaposition, and why not observe Safeguarding Sunday on the designated day of 20 November? There are three reasons:

- 1. There are reminders in the readings for today as to what the life of faith looks like. 'Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.' A fundamental principle of how we deal with others.
- 2. As we reflect on the Saints we contemplate the kind of people we are called to be and therefore how we should live. Safeguarding and keeping others safe is a fundamental part of loving one's neighbour.
- 3. There are significant pressures on many at present, with the essentials of life such as food and heat at risk. Such conditions may give rise to safeguarding concerns as so it is important that we should be aware and equipped to assist appropriately.
